FIRST AFTERNOON:

Meeting **the Ju/'hoan Bushmen/ San community of N//hoq'ma** through a guide from the village who takes you around. The guide will explain to guests how they live in their family groups. The community will also play some of their traditional games and lores. Starts from 3 PM (winter) or 4 PM (summer).

There is an **art market** in the village where guests can have a look around if they are interested

NEXT MORNING:

Guests will accompany a group of four **hunters** with the guide into the surrounding field on foot. The hunters will **search for fresh tracks, follow the bees for honey or go look in holes for porcupine or springhare**. If something interesting is found, the walk turns in to a hunt. Antilope are seldomly hunted these days, but the chance for successfully harvesting honey or hunting smaller animals is roughly 1/5. It is always very eventful and interesting. During the walk/hunt with men, various skills are demonstrated: **bush medicine, plant foods, finding water, tracking, hunting techniques and equipment, fire making.** The walk will start after breakfast around 7:30 am to roughly 12:00am.

AFTERNOON:

Making hunting equipment with the huntershells in the village with a guide explaining.

ONE EVENING:

A healing dance will be observed on one of the evenings.

KHAUDUM NATIONAL PARK

Full day trip to Khaudum National Park. The park border is only 40km away, but it takes about 1,5 hours to reach. We leave early after breakfast and are back in time for dinner. 3 or 4 waterholes in the south of the park will be part of our route. Lunch with a view at one of the hides at the waterhole.

Would clients like to explore more of Khaudum, we offer a two-day trip with overnight camping and catering on request.

NYAE NYAE PANS

Full day trip to Nyae Nyae Pans. Best time to visit is after April, when the area has dried out from the rains and roads are accessible. The region is dotted with huge Baobab trees and rich bird life (often flamingo's in the pans). Sometimes large herds of antelopes can be found more in the south. The natural pans used to be the hotspot for the Ju/'hoan San in dry season, until boreholes were drilled from the 1970's on and water was available elsewhere. We leave early after breakfast and are back in time for dinner. Lunch with a view at one of the hides at the waterhole.

(NEW) TWO-NIGHT CAMP OUT WITH THE SAN HUNTERS IN THE FIELD.

Walk away from the camp with a group of hunters and a guide for two nights of pure bush experience. This is the most adventurous it will get. Food and water will be provided and tents will be put up in base camp. Meals will be cooked in group over the fire. Guests can explore the untouched wilderness and have the great opportunity to experience the culture in a unique way. Take time to learn about nature and wildlife with the guidance of the San hunters. Evenings will be entertained with traditional storytelling.

The activity will be only offered during the dry season (April- September). It has a great potential or nature lovers who would like to have deeper immersion in the nature wisdom and culture of the bushman.



KHAUDUM ESCORTS:

Allow at least 2 days to drive through the park from South to North with camping at Sikereti or Khaudum camps. Entrance and camping fees are for the guest's own account. If the escort ends in the north at the tarred road, an extra day is charged for guide and vehicle to return to base.

DIRECTIONS:

The turn-off is approximately 185 km on the C44 gravel road when coming from Grootfontein or 40 km from Tsumkwe. Nhoma is 40 km along the D3312; 4WD not required, but a vehicle with good clearance is best for the sandy stretches after Vicksrus village on the final 20 km. Two wheel drive vehicles must park below the dune and wait to be picked up.

NHOMA AIRSTRIP:

2km from camp - S19deg14min14sec and E020deg14min10sec. Elevation 3790 ft. Length 1000m. Direction: 09/27

TRANSFERS:

The cost for transfers is N\$15 per kilometer per vehicle, return trip. Therefore, pickup from Tsumkwe will cost N\$15 x 80 x 2 = N\$2400. The drop-off will cost the same again.

CLIMATE

Temperatures reach 39 deg C from mid-September to November in the shade. Winter night time temperatures can drop below zero deg C. Heavy rains can fall between January and April. Best time to visit: April to June and September. It is a malaria-endemic area, but there are few mosquitoes due to it being a sandy area.
